### **Conditions of this permit**

1. The permit is specific to the business name/holder as shown above and shall not be transferable
2. Only species shown above may be processed under this licence.
3. The permit shall restrict production to the above-mentioned specified fish and fishery products official approval shall be sought from Kiribati Competent Authority (CA) prior to the development or introduction of new additional products or species.
4. The licence shall be conspicuously displayed on the premises in respect of which it was granted.
5. The licence shall require the Kiribati Seafood Verification Agency (KSVA) to subject the approved establishment and products therein to regular inspection according to the Kiribati National Control Plan and Industry Standards.
6. All fish species (especially albacore, yellowfin and bigeye tuna) offloaded to the processing establishment shall be legally caught and not derived from toxic species or species containing biotoxins.
7. All fish processed under this licence shall be caught, landed where appropriate packaged, handled, marked, prepared, processed, frozen, thawed, stored and transported under conditions laid down in the Fish Export Regulations 2012, laying down the health conditions of the productions and the placing on the market of fishery products and in accordance with an approved HACCP (Hazard analysis and Critical control point) plan.
8. The product must undergone health controls under the control of KSVA or CA.
9. The plant or permit holder shall pose in hand an approved HACCP plan by the KSVA or CA.
